We Value Your Membership

As a member of The Knights of Columbus you are part of the world's largest Catholic family fraternal service organization with over 1.9 million members. As a Knight you provide members and their families with volunteer opportunities in service to the Catholic Church, our community, families and young people.

When you joined the Knights of Columbus it gave you an opportunity to change your life. As a Knight, you have the opportunity to strengthen your parish, give back to our community, and grow in your faith.

When you joined council 4386 it did not mean that you have to sacrifice quality time with your family. By volunteering an hour here or an hour there – with your family – it can make an enormous difference in your life and in the lives of others.

As with most organizations membership requires a commitment, and an annual payment of dues. Council 4386 depends on the prompt payment of dues from it's members.

The annual membership fee at council 4386 is \$55.00 if paid before the end of February of the current year, otherwise a \$5.00 surcharge is added to cover extra costs for rebilling, stamps, envelopes etc.

If a brother knight does not pay his annual membership dues our council is obliged to submit the per capita fees to Supreme and State Council, leaving our council with a loss of funds.

If you wish to discontinue your membership you must submit a dated and signed letter to the Supreme Council indicating your wish to discontinue your membership, until Supreme Council receives your notice of intent Council 4386 must continue to pay on your behalf the per capita tax. These extra funds could otherwise be used buy our council to help support local charitable works. (If you are an insurance member, this action will not affect your Insurance coverage.)

We understand with busy life styles, family responsibilities etc. it's easy to forget. If you have fallen behind with your dues we ask that you take the time now to bring them up to date. For those who have already paid, thank you.

Golf League

If you are interested in Golfing on a Senior's League we would love to hear from you. We are a small group of golfers who range in age from our 60's into our 70's and a few in the 80's. This is a fun league where we have two Fun Days in the Season. One half way through the season and one on our final day of Golf. On our final Day we all share in a Steak Dinner and in some prize money . We also play a Match Game series during the second half of the Season.

League Details:

Season: First week of May to the Second week of October. (24 weeks)

Course: Belleview Golf Club, Woodslee, Ontario

Rates: There are several to choose from. Two popular packages are the 20 round deal and the Frequent Players deal. The 20 round package is available for those who walk or ride. This year the walking rate was \$400 plus tax for seniors , with a cart you add \$200 plus tax. The Frequent Player rate is for someone who is going to ride each week. You pay for the 10th round in advance and then pay each week for golf. When you get to the 10th week, you golf without paying since it was prepaid. Check the Belleview Website for all their rates at "www.belleviewgolf.ca".



There is also a League rate that covers 24 weeks but with rain weeks and missed weeks for personal reasons, the 20 Round and Frequent Players packages work well.

Rules: We play from the Senior Tees. On Holes that play a little long, we use the forward Tees. It's is all about having fun, making pars and birdies if we can.

Day and Time: Our first group Tees off at 7:30am each Thursday of the season. There is no penalty if you miss golf. No need to get a spare.

Teams: Teams are large. This year we had groups of 8. We used the 6 best scores for each week to determine team standings.

Additional Fees: Each golfer pays \$60 for the season. This covers the two Fun Day meals and prize money for each Fun Day. We also play a Closest to the Pin on one Par 3 hole each week. The cost is \$1. The prize is half the pot each week. The other half goes into the general prize money fund.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS HOLY FAMILY COUNCIL 4386 BURSARY AWARDS



The Knights of Columbus Holy Family Council 4386 awards up to \$1500 annually for bursaries. The awards are open for any accredited post secondary education. The maximum bursary is \$500. The bursaries will be awarded by a Selection Committee subject to the following conditions:

1. a) The applicant must be a member, or son or daughter or ward of a member, or a deceased member. The member must be in good standing. (paid-up member of Holy Family Council 4386)
- b) The applicant must be a graduating student from a Windsor-Essex District Secondary School.
- c) The Applicant must provide proof of acceptance in the first year of a recognized post secondary institution and continue in regular attendance for at least one school year.
2. The decision of the Bursary Committee shall be based on faith, academic proficiency, involvement in school, community and church activities and financial need.
3. Power of the Bursary Committee: The decisions of the Committee in making the awards and all final decisions of the Bursary Fund and the Administration thereof shall be final.
4. The award shall not be paid until the successful applicant is enrolled and attending the recognized accredited post-secondary institution of his/her choice. One-half(50%) of the bursary will be given at the beginning of the First semester upon proof of enrollment and one-half(50%) will be given in the second semester upon proof of enrollment.
